HEADS (SIDES) SQUARE THRU FOUR HANDS AROUND GO,
FIND THAT CORNER **DO-SA-DO**
DO A **RIGHT AND LEFT THRU** AND TURN THE LADY
SLIDE THRU AND LOAD OLD SANTA'S BOAT
*MOST OF DECEMBER'S STILL IN AUTUMN
SWING AND PROMENADE HER SOON
AND THE WEATHER'S SO UN NERVING
THIS YEAR SANTA ARRIVED IN A MONSOON

BREAK AND ENDING: (CIRCLE LEFT)

LEFT ALLEMANDE THE CORNER WEAVE THE RING
