GO ALL THE WAY THEN **SWING THRU . . .**
. . . **SWING THRU** AGAIN, (BALANCE HERE)
ALL EIGHT CIRCULATE, SWING WITH THE CORNER
SWING AND PROMENADE THE FLOOR
NOW I'LL NEVER DANCE WITH ANOTHER
SINCE I SAW HER STANDING THERE

BREAK & CLOSER: (SIDES FACE, GRAND SQUARE)

WE DANCED THRU THE NIGHT, HELD EACHOTHER TIGHT
