FIGURE:

HEADS (SIDES) PROMENADE HALF WAY
WALK IN AND **PASS THE OCEAN, EXTEND,**
SWING THRU, BOYS RUN RIGHT MY FRIEND
FERRIS WHEEL, RIGHT AND LEFT THRU
HALF SASHAY, U-TURN BACK AND
SWING THAT **CORNER PROMENADE**
NOBODY HERE CAN WALK IT FOR YOU

MIDDLE BREAK: SIDES FACE GRAND SQUARE (KEY CHANGE)

THERE'S A ROAD THAT LEADS TO GLORY
