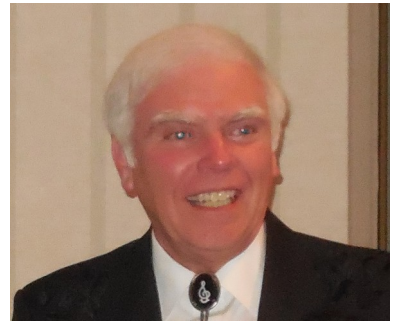

### **OPENER: (SIDES FACE GRAND SQUARE)**

THERE'S AN OCEAN OF STARS  
HOVERING OVER ME  
I LAY UNDER THEM DREAMING  
YOUR FACE ALL I SEE

### **ALLEMANDE AND WEAVE. . .**

I'M CAUGHT UP, IN A FEVER, SHIVERING TOO  
ALL THAT'S KEEPING ME ALIVE  
IS THE THOUGHT OF LOSING YOU

### **FIGURE:**

**HEADS (SIDES) SQUARE THRU** FOUR HANDS AND GO  
**DO SA DO** THE OUTSIDE TWO  
**SWING THRU . . BOYS RUN RIGHT**  
**HALF TAG THE LINE, SCOOT BACK**  
**BOYS RUN RIGHT** THEN A **RIGHT AND LEFT THRU**  
FULL TURN, KEEP THAT GIRL AND **PROMENADE. .**  
SO HOLD ON JUANITA, I'LL FIND YOU AGAIN.

### **BREAK:**

**FOUR LADIES CHAIN,** TURN WITH THAT GIRL  
**ROLLAWAY AND CIRCLE LEFT**  
**FOUR LADIES ROLLAWAY, CIRCLE** AGAIN  
**LEFT ALLEMANDE** AND YOU **WEAVE THAT RING**  
YOU ARE THE OCEAN, I AM A GRAIN OF SAND  
SO HOLD ON JUANITA, I'LL FIND YOU AGAIN.

### **CLOSER: SIDES FACE GRAND SQUARE**

OH, JUANITA WHERE'D YOUR MAMMA GET THAT NAME  
THERE'S NO SENIORITA'S FROM THE MOUNTAINS WHERE YOU CAME  
**ALLEMANDE AND WEAVE THE RING**  
AND IF I EVER SAW ONE  
SHE WOULDN'T BE AS PRETTY AS YOU  
WITH BLACK HAIR SO LONG  
AND SOFT EYES SO BLUE  
SO HOLD ON JUANITA, I'LL FIND YOU AGAIN.
